Chistmas Eve - SALVATION

Tomorrow is the day that we have been Hoping and waiting for! It is a day of Joy when we celebrate the birth of our Savior. Read the following verses together:

As you light the center white candle, reflect on how Jesus is the Light of the world. You are a reflection of His light. On this Christmas Eve, we celebrate by lighting this last candle and listening to Jesus' words in the Bible, so that we can let our light shine for others to see. Merry Christmas!

PRAYER TIME

Pray to God with praises and thanksgiving! Tell Him how thankful you are that He gave us Jesus. Ask God what your next step is to knowing Jesus more.

ACTIVITY

Parents, as you gather around the advent wreath for the last time this season, take some time to talk about how you decided to trust Jesus for the first time. Sharing your own personal testimony of what Jesus means to you and what following Him looks like will allow your child to see that faith is personal. This may even spark conversations for them asking more questions about what it means to follow Jesus. Follow the Holy Spirit's prompting and lean into these conversations with your family.

PRAYER TIME

ACTIVITY

Write everyone's names on scraps of paper and place them in a bag. Have each person draw a name from the bag. Keep the name you draw a secret. Sometime this week, write a letter to the person you picked saying one thing you are thankful for about that person. Think about how you are anticipating and looking forward to your letter just like we wait to celebrate the birth of Jesus during advent.

Gather some Post-it notes and take turns writing words on individual notes to describe Advent. Stick them to a wall where everyone can see them. Each evening this week, turn out the lights and look at your words using a flashlight to light up the darkness. Talk about how you have been experiencing the words throughout the week. Christmas will be here soon! Let the flashlight remind you how Jesus is the light of the world. His light reveals what is true and brings us Peace.

PRAYER TIME

ACTIVITY

Pick a household object that gives you joy. Maybe it is a favorite toy or something that reminds you of a time of celebration. Take turns hiding it every morning this week and help each other find it throughout the day. At the end of every day, put it somewhere where everyone can see it. Whenever you look at it, think about how the prophets eagerly awaited the birth of their savior, and how the angels told the shepherds of the good news of Jesus' birth.
