Listen to this Week's Sermon

Mon | Read/Listen to Matt. 2:13-23 | Worship to "Take You At Your Word" Jesus unveils the path to *salvation*. What echoes of the Exodus story do you hear? They may be explicit or a bit more veiled. Write them out. How does this reinforce the need to be "Word-dependent" as you follow Jesus? Ask Jesus, "What does living in your kingdom look like for me today?"

Tuesday | Read/Listen to 2 Corinthians 1:3-22 | Worship to "Promises"

Jesus completes God's promise of salvation to all. How does knowing that all of God's promises are fulfilled in Jesus give you confidence in God's faithfulness today? What promises from Scripture have you experienced in your own life through Jesus? What are you waiting for right now? How can you intentionally build your faith as you wait? Ask Jesus, "What does living in your kingdom look like for me today?"

Wednesday | Read/Listen to Exodus 1:1-3:12 | Worship to "This Is Our God"

The Exodus pattern is a salvation story. How does this passage show God's heart to save his people? What purpose does God reveal for his salvation? In what ways has God saved you, and how might he be calling you to live out his purpose today? Ask Jesus, "What does living in your kingdom look like for me today?"

Thursday | Read/Listen to Ex. 6:1-13 | Worship to "Graves Into Gardens"

Salvation is a new life in God's kingdom marked by God's presence. How does your view of "salvation" influence how you live? What motivates you to follow Jesus closely? Focus on v. 7. How does this reflect our story as followers of Jesus? Ask Jesus, "What does living in your kingdom look like for me today?"

Friday | Read/Listen to Psalm 16 | Worship to "Fullness Of Joy"

Jesus unveils the path to *salvation*. Meditate on this Psalm as you read/listen to it at least two more times. How does this psalm remind you of what God has already done for you? How does it bring to mind what Jesus is doing in you? How does it remind you of his purpose for you? Ask Jesus, "What does living in your kingdom look like for me today?"
