# Lifestyle of Worship

## **Definition**

Worship is the act and attitude of wholeheartedly giving yourself to God – spirit, soul and body.

#### **Beliefs**

I. We believe that worship is ascribing worth and honor to Who God is and responding to Him with trust, obedience, and thanksgiving.

...ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name. Bring an offering and come before him; worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness. 1 Chronicles 16:29

How lovely is your dwelling place, O LORD Almighty! My soul yearns, even faints, for the courts of the LORD; my heart and my flesh cry out for the living God. Even the sparrow has found a home, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may have her young — a place near your altar, O LORD Almighty, my King and my God. Blessed are those who dwell in your house; they are ever praising you. Selah Psalm 84:1-4

Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. Psalm 100:4

II. We believe that the Kingdom of Heaven is near at hand.

Come near to God and he will come near to you. James 4:8

The trumpeters and singers joined in unison, as with one voice, to give praise and thanks to the Lord. VI. We believe that God commands, deserves, and enjoys our worship.

Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." Matthew 22:37

Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only." Matthew 4:10

VII. We believe that worship helps us to see God for who He truly is and see ourselves as we truly are.

O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens. From the lips of children and infants you have ordained praise because of your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger. When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him? You made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor. You made him ruler over the works of your hands; you put everything under his feet: all flocks and herds, and the beasts of the field, the birds of the air, and the fish of the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas. O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! Psalm 8:1-9

VIII. We believe that Communion is the celebration and commemoration of the Lord's sacrifice on the cross.

For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

IX. We believe that any act of obedience to God in faith is an act of Worship.

Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship. Romans 12:1
