LIVE IT OUT TOGETHER | STUDY • DISCUSS • APPLY

Read Acts 2:14-21. Who was standing with Peter as he preached? How could folks today stand with those who preach the Word of God? Describe the types of people on whom the Spirit is poured. What does the Spirit enable them to do (*vs. 18*)? When have you felt power to speak the truth of God to another? Which verses in Joel's prophecy tell about coming judgement and how to be saved?

Read Acts 2:22-41. List several basic facts about Jesus that Peter included in his Gospel-centered message. Which of these facts is most compelling to you? Why? How do the words, "Whom you crucified," apply just the same to you and me today (*Romans 3:10, 23*)? Tell of a time you have been "cut to the heart" by the scriptures. Read Hebrews 4:12. What is promised to those who repent according to Acts 2:38-39? Tell about a time when you became aware of these gifts.

Read Acts 2:42-47. List the practices that resulted in the church when they were Spirit-empowered. Which practice would you most like God to grow in you?
