Exclusivity

The Big Idea: Following Jesus requires embracing exclusivity.

To “listen” = to do

Jesus is our God, Jesus alone.

When we remake Jesus into whom we want him to be,
we are no longer following Jesus.

LIVE IT OUT TOGETHER | STUDY • DISCUSS • APPLY

Monday | Read Deuteronomy 6:4, Mark 4:9

The word "hear" means to take action. When have you heard something from a friend or parent and agreed, but not taken action? Why does this happen? What truth from God's Word have you heard and put into practice? Pray... "Jesus, you are my God, you alone!"

Tuesday | Read Deuteronomy 6:4

This verse can also be translated, "The Lord is our God, the Lord alone." How does this put Jesus in an exclusive place in your life? What does it look like to give "exclusivity" to Jesus in your school, work, relationships, finances, and even recreation? What could we do to remind each other that Jesus is our God, Jesus alone?

Wednesday | Read Deuteronomy 5:1-21

This passage lays out the 10 Commandments. As we focus on the third one (v11), how has misusing the Lord's name become commonplace? What does it mean to honor the name of Jesus? Why is it important? How can we "hear" and put this command into practice this week? Pray... "Jesus, you are my God, you alone!"

Thursday | Read Deuteronomy 6:4-5 & Mark 12:28-31

Why do you think Jesus called the Shema the greatest commandment? What benefit is it to recite God's Word both morning and night? Could it help you to repeat this or another scripture regularly? How can we make talking about Jesus a normal part of our lives?

Friday | Read Mark 4:3-20

The soil represents how we hear and respond to God's word. What are the obstacles to truly hearing God? What can you do to cultivate "the soil of your heart" so you can hear and take action on God's word? Pray... "Jesus, you are my God, you alone!"
