My Story Questions

These questions/activities help the group know one another and transition to deeper discussion. Choose one. OR.... You might start each meeting with one person sharing highlights of their story for 5-8 minutes.

- 1) What is your favorite part of a wedding ceremony or reception?
- 2) If you could gorge yourself on a certain food item, what would it be?

Study Questions

These are meant for personal preparation and group discussion. Use all or pick a few to discuss.

- 1) Read Revelation 19:6-10** What is the reason the multitude is singing "Halleluia"?
- 2) How is a wedding a good picture of the gospel?
- 3) What righteous acts (white linen) has God provided for you to participate in and how have they transformed you?
- 4) What acts of worship can show your joy at the more perfect union we will one day share?
- 5) Read Revelation 19: 11-16** List the images and attributes of the Lord you see. Which stands out the most to you?
- 6) Why is it significant that a sharp sword would be coming out of his mouth and how does that relate to his title, "Word of God"?
- 7) How do the written Word and the living Word work together in your life? See Hebrews 4:12-13
- 8) Read Revelation 19:17-21** How is the "Great supper of God" different from the "Wedding supper"?
- 9) Why do you think God put this portion of scripture here for us to read?"
- 10) Read Revelation 20:1-10** How much effort did it take Jesus to overthrow Satan's forces and what does that tell you about Jesus' power? How does that change the way you perceive your spiritual battles?
- 11) Who will come to life and reign with Jesus and how is that motivating to you today?
- 12) Read Revelation 20:11-15, Matthew 25:31-46, Matthew 7:13-14** How do the "Books" represent two options for eternity and how else did Jesus express this reality?
- 13) Which is more motivating to you, the joys of heaven or the escape from hell? Why?
- 14) How is the book of Revelation giving me courage and motivating action?"

Responding to Jesus

Offer these questions for personal reflection before your group prayer time.

- 1) Lord, "How can I better listen for your voice as I read your Word"?
- 2) Lord, "If I were to focus more on what is to come, how would that change my actions today?"

Further Study

Investigate the 3 major views of the Millennium Reign: Premillennialism, Postmillennialism and Amillennialism. Smart, Jesus loving scholars are divided on this issue so hold it loosely but dig in and establish your viewpoint.
