LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

Monday | Read Psalm 118

God is good and can be trusted. How have you experienced that God's love "endures"? Where has doubt about God's goodness crept into your thinking in the past? What's a story of God's goodness from your life that you could share with others? How might you follow up if you invited someone to experience God's love this Easter? Ask Jesus, "Where can I demonstrate your goodness in someone else's life today?"

Tuesday | Read 2 Corinthians 12:7-10

Jesus' victory reminds us of his strength in our weakness. What is difficult about the truth of this passage? How has God worked in and through you during a time of weakness? How do you see the spiritual warfare we talked about last week impact how you read this? Ask Jesus, "Where do I need to recognize my weakness and depend on your strength today?"

Wednesday | Focus on Psalm 118:19-25

Life brings trouble, but Jesus is victorious. For what do you need to cry out to God for help today? What can you do this week to prepare yourself for the joy of resurrection that awaits us on Sunday? Reread verses 24 & 25 five times. Ask Jesus, "What do you want to remind me of as I think about your power to save?"

Thursday | Read Luke 22:39-46

Jesus is our strength! What's surprising or confusing in this passage? How does it impact you to know that Jesus was strengthened by his Father as he faced betrayal and death? How does what you learned about spiritual beings help you understand this passage? Ask Jesus, "Where are you asking me to get real in my conversation with you?"

Friday | Read Luke 23:26-49

Ask Jesus, "What do you want to teach me today?" Thank Jesus for his gift of trading his life for your life. Attend a Good Friday service at your campus today! Harrison Lane: 4:30 & 6:00 pm | Roane County & Bearden: 6:00 pm
