Big Idea: God's story is unfolding in a world opposed to God's people.

What does that mean for a follower of Jesus today?

Live with your "eyes open" to the spiritual nature of the opposition.

Know God is at work behind your confusion.

Confusing circumstances are not an indication of the final story.

What you need to know as you read this week:

- You'll be reading the setup (the first 9 plagues) to the big exit in the 10th plague.
- Egyptian pharaohs believed they were gods.
- Look for the phrase "Then the Lord said to Moses" and how it is used in the story.
- The plagues are on areas of life believed to be governed by Egyptian gods.
- The plagues are in 3 sets of 3 before the final plague. Look for the pattern.

*** Before you read or listen to the story each day, ask Jesus, "What do you want me to see in your story today?" ***

Monday | Read Exodus 7:1-8:15

God's story is unfolding in a world actively opposed to his people. How does the first plague connect to the end of chapter 1? How do you see God directing the action in the story? Why is that important?

Tuesday | Read Exodus 8:16-9:7

We live with our "eyes open" to the spiritual nature of the opposition. How does the interaction between Moses, Aaron, and Pharaoh reflect that there is more to the story than may appear on the surface? What are the phrases you see/hear repeated in the story? How do they help you see the pattern of the story? Why might this be important?

Wednesday | Read Exodus 9:8-10:20

There is more to the story than God delivering the Israelites from bondage in Egypt. How would you summarize God's intentions at this point of the story? Why is it important to remember that Pharaoh is not innocent in this story?

Thursday | Read Exodus 10:21-12:28

Great stories build tension. How has the tension between God (through Moses) and Pharaoh been made through the story this week? After the ninth plague, the pattern changes. What does this leave the reader/listener anticipating? Before God delivers the tenth and final plague, he commands the Israelites to intentionally remember through the generations what was about to come. How does this emphasize God's intentions in this story?

Friday | Watch "Torah Series Episode 2: Genesis 12-50"

How would you summarize God's plan through Abraham and his offspring? What's the pattern you see of how Abraham's offspring behave and how God responds? Where have you seen that pattern already in the book of Exodus?
