LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

*** Before you read or listen to the story each day, ask Jesus, "What do you want me to see in your story today?" ***

Monday | Read Exodus 32:1-35

What seems to be at the core of the Israelites' desire for an idol? How do you tend to respond when God seems silent or absent? Notice who is said to have brought the people "up out of the land of Egypt" in this passage - what is surprising about that? How does God show both mercy and justice in his response? What is surprising or confusing in this passage?

Tuesday | Read Exodus 33:1-23

God's presence demonstrates he is trustworthy. Why does God's presence seem to be so important? What contrast do you see in the conversation between Yahweh and Moses with the first encounter at the burning bush? Ask Jesus, "As I face what's beyond me, where do I need to know and experience your presence?"

Wednesday | Read Exodus 34:1-35

Consider God's own description of himself (vv.6-7). Where have you seen these attributes already portrayed in his story? How does it compare with your own experience of him? How does Moses' return from the mountain the second time contrast from the first (32:15-35)?

Thursday | Read Exodus 35:1-29

Highlight/underline every time you hear God speak about the "heart" of the people. Why do you think attitude is emphasized in this passage? How does this contrast to what has come before in the story?

Friday | Watch "Torah Series Episode 6: Numbers"

How does the name "Numbers" leave you uninterested in this book? How has this series helped you connect the first five books (Torah) of the Bible? The goal is for you to know the basic storyline of these books. How would you summarize the story?
