LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

*** Before you read or listen to the story each day, ask Jesus, "What do you want me to see in your story today?" ***

Monday | Read Exodus 35:30-37:16

How do you see God providing for the work he called his people to do? Have you experienced that? Why do you think Exodus spends so much space describing the precise work done to build the Tabernacle and Ark? Did you notice how this compares with chapters 25 and 26? What does this communicate to you?

Tuesday | Read Exodus 37:17-38:7

What does the repeated use of poles for carrying say about God and the relationship between him and his people? In what ways has reading through the whole book of Exodus impacted your understanding of God's relationship with humanity? With the Israelites? With you?

Wednesday | Read Exodus 38:8-31

Much of this week's reading has a parallel passage earlier in Exodus, but the list of materials is new. What stands out to you about the project cost in terms of raw materials and manpower? Where do you think these valuable materials came from (see 12:35-36)? How does this demonstrate the way God works in his story? How has reading through Exodus impacted the way you understand God's story?

Thursday | Read Exodus 39-40

How we follow matters. Highlight/underline each time you see something done "as the LORD had commanded." What does this say about God? Moses? Us? What purpose for the tabernacle do the cloud and fire confirm? What would that have meant to the people? How would you summarize the point of the Exodus story?

Friday | Watch "Torah Series Episode 7: Deuteronomy"

How has your understanding of the Bible's first five books grown or changed over the past seven weeks? What is essential to know about the book of Deuteronomy? Pray, "Jesus, how do I place myself in the middle of your story today?"
