

Summary

The Tech Director oversees Two Rivers Church campuses' audio, technical maintenance, and integration elements. This position is responsible for ensuring excellent technical quality for all events that fall within its scope of responsibility. Recruiting, training, and empowering volunteers are key components of this position.

Major Responsibilities

This role requires specialization in the technical maintenance and upkeep of systems, the quality of audio and music production, and the training of and investment in volunteers under these defined fields. Major responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Manage weekend audio production
- Manage weekly stage setups
- Manage loop premix preparation and ensuring global quality
- Manage tech and production equipment maintenance

Other Responsibilities

- Participating in meetings to ensure quality control of technical and overall audio production: weekend debriefs, production meetings, regularly scheduled meetings with supervisor/residents, etc.
- Overseeing the audio of weekend services for each venue/campus in partnership with the Worship, Production, and Tech Staff to provide excellent, creative, and engaging worship environments
- Overseeing the technical elements of various special services/events as deemed necessary.
- Overseeing the purchasing and maintenance of technical equipment for all campuses, ensuring technological relevance while maintaining good stewardship of fiscal resources. Manage, alongside the Production Director, the creation and execution of the annual tech budget
- Overseeing volunteer teams: recruit, train, schedule, empower, and disciple.
- Ensuring proper functionality of audio needs for midweek gathering: bible studies, student ministries, the Well, etc.
- Ensuring proper setup, tear down, and cleanliness of stages for weekly services and other events/venues.
- Supervising any residents and/or interns within the Tech ministry.
- Enlisting the aid of the Facilities Director for all technical capital projects and overseeing the execution of said projects.
- Working with other staff members to be supportive of their ministries.
