Monday | Read Mark 1:21-34

Jesus' authority over the supernatural reveals that the Kingdom of God is here. Imagine you were in the synagogue that day. What would the mood be like in the room? What would you be thinking? What kind of king is Jesus showing himself to be in this passage? How might someone live if they have a king like that? Ask Jesus, "What do I need to know is true about life in your kingdom?"

Tuesday | Focus on Mark 1:35-39

Our prayers ground us in the supernatural. Why do you think Jesus got away to pray? What do you do when you need to get away and be with God? Can you remember a time when God used silence or solitude to engage with you? What do Jesus' actions reveal about God's kingdom? Plan to get away with God soon - even just for an hour!

Wednesday | Read Mark 1:40-45

Touching the man would have made Jesus ceremonially unclean. What does this scene demonstrate about Jesus' power and authority? What do you think were the motives people had when flocking to Jesus? Do you think those motives matter? What do you learn about Jesus as king in this passage?

Thursday | Read Mark 2:1-12

Jesus is king over the natural and supernatural. Imagine the scene in the house. What might people have thought as the sermon was interrupted and the house damaged? What is Jesus revealing about himself and his kingdom through his words and actions? This scene raised many questions for those in the crowd. What questions does it raise for you? Ask Jesus, "Where do I need to trust in your power today?"

Friday | Review Mark 1:21-2:12

The good news is supernatural. As you read back through this passage, how would you summarize what Jesus is doing? How does this passage help you better understand what kind of king Jesus is or what his kingdom is like? Ask God, "What truth about life in your kingdom do you want me to believe today?"
