LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

Monday | Read Mark 4:35-5:20

The "good news" is made real when Jesus is our king. What tone do you imagine Jesus used when questioning his disciples in v. 40? Notice the ways people respond to Jesus' power in these two miracles. What does it reveal about him? About people? Have you encountered the power of Jesus? How did you respond? Respond to him in worship right now!

Tuesday | Read Mark 5:21-6:6

Jesus is the king revealed through all of God's story. What does Jesus demonstrate his authority over in this passage (and the last)? When was the last time you "fell down before Jesus" and begged him for help? What do you think of the response of Jesus' hometown crowd? Can you sympathize with them? How would you describe the Jesus portrayed in this passage? Ask Jesus, "How am I limiting my understanding of who you are and what you can do?"

Wednesday | Read Mark 6:7-6:56

Jesus' kingship demands a response. What stands out to you about how the 12 apostles were sent out? How would you summarize their mission? What do you notice about what happened when they returned? Notice that Jesus doesn't give up on his disciples when they don't understand or their hearts are hard - that's good news for us! How have you experienced this characteristic of King Jesus? Ask Jesus, "Where are you calling me to respond to you today?"

Thursday | Read Mark 7:1-7:30

Only Jesus gets to define his kingship. What does Jesus' teaching here reveal about the nature of his kingdom? The woman who comes to Jesus is a Gentile (non-Jew). Why is this significant in light of what Jesus just taught? What does this reveal about his kingdom and his message? Ask Jesus, "Who do I know who might think your good news is not for them?"

Friday | Review Mark 7:31-8:30

The "good news" is made real when Jesus is our king. It's significant that the first part of this passage (through v10) takes place in a Gentile area. What stands out to you in this passage? What questions does it raise for you? Do you think Jesus is being uncompassionate when he refuses to give "a sign from heaven"? Why might he do that? Do you agree with Peter's declaration? What does that mean for how you relate to Jesus? Ask Jesus, "How can I show your kind of compassion today?"

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
