LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

Monday | Read/Listen to Jude | Listen to "Crowns Down"

Living it out requires a deep foundation that begins with submission to Jesus. What stands out in Jude's greeting in this letter (Jude 1-4)? How does reminding yourself that you are "owned" by Jesus stand as both a comfort and a challenge? Ask Jesus, "Where have I rejected your authority?"

Tuesday | Read/Listen to 2 Peter 2 | Listen to "Christ Is Enough"

It's believed Peter had access to Jude's letter and used it as he wrote 2 Peter. What similarities do you see between 2 Peter and Jude? How does Peter's letter give you more insight into Jude's letter? What does it look like to actively guard against false teachings today? Ask Jesus, "Who can I encourage in the faith today?"

Wednesday | Read/Listen to Numbers 16 | Listen to "Only A Holy God"

A deep foundation is built on God's story. The story of Korah's rebellion is a dramatic reminder of God's justice for those who oppose God's purposes. How does being familiar with this story heighten the message of Jude? What emotion does this story evoke? How does this letter reinforce the need to read and study all of Scripture? Ask Jesus, "Where in my life do I need to trust your justice is perfect?"

Thursday | Read/Listen to Jude | Listen to "Christ Be All Around Me"

The Holy Spirit's real-world presence makes a deep foundation possible. What can seem overwhelming becomes possible with the Holy Spirit's guidance. What characteristics of false teachers does Jude denounce? Why is it important to know the difference between a disagreement in "doctrine" and a false teacher described by Jude? Ask Jesus, "How can I pray for the leaders/teachers in my life?"

Friday | Watch the BibleProject Video on Jude | Listen to "Firm Foundation" Living it out requires a deep foundation. The BibleProject points toward the whole-life response in living out our faith as we follow Jesus. What are the core truths we need to guard? What are some beliefs that are not essential? Why is it important to know the difference between them? How does this connect with the truths we learned from Philemon of living relationally connected, united in Christ, and forgiving each other? Ask Jesus, "How can I put this truth into motion today?"
