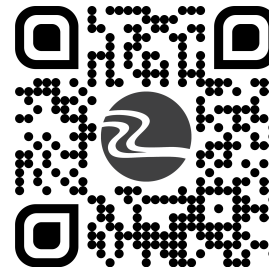

LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

Psalm 119 uses precepts, statutes, and testimonies all to refer to God's Word and guidance. "Precepts" emphasize specific principles for righteous living, "statutes" highlight authoritative laws, and "testimonies" underscore God's declarations and witness to His will. Together, these terms express the richness and completeness of God's revelation and guidance through His Word.

Monday | Listen to [Psalm 119:121-128](#) | Listen to [Cornerstone](#)
Pray Psalm 119:121-128. How does knowing God's character build confidence and trust? What can you do to cultivate trust in Jesus based on his character? How does this encourage you to seek him for guidance? How might this prepare you for adversity? Ask Jesus, "What's one area in my life I struggle to submit to your authority?"

Tuesday | Listen to [Psalm 119:129-136](#) | Listen to [The Jesus Way](#)
Pray Psalm 119:129-136. Love requires an investment of time and energy. What investment can you make to grow your love for God's Word? How does a love for God's Word illuminate a world broken by sin? Ask Jesus, "Where are you asking me to embrace both loving your Word and loving people who don't know you yet?"

Wednesday | Listen to [Psalm 119:137-144](#) | Listen to [Authority](#)
Pray Psalm 119:137-144. How does recognizing our "smallness" contribute to humility and dependence on God's guidance? How does this contrast with the consistent messaging from our culture? Do you sometimes struggle between the truth of God's Word and the reality of the world in which we live? How can praying this Psalm help you place your life under Jesus' authority? Ask Jesus, "What thought about myself do you want to transform?"

Thursday | Listen to [Psalm 119:145-152](#) | Listen to [Lord I Need You](#)
Pray Psalm 119:145-152. When do you find yourself crying out to God? How can you move this to a consistent spiritual practice instead of a reaction to circumstances? How might this develop your love for Jesus and the written Word? How does the psalmist's joy in God's Word inspire your attitude toward listening to, reading, or studying Scripture? Ask Jesus, "What truth about you do you want me to think about throughout today?"

Friday | Listen to [Psalm 119:121-160](#) | Listen to [Available](#)
Pray Psalm 119:153-160. Review this week. In what ways do you "hear" God communicating with you? How does investing your time to serve others reflect the character of Jesus? What does serving people who love Jesus and those who do not yet know Jesus mean? Sign up for Serve Saturday on Feb. 3rd!
