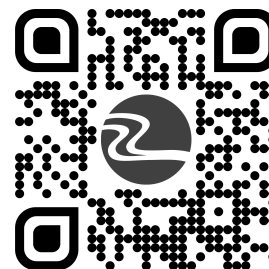

LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

Psalm 119 uses eight words to refer to God's Word and guidance; we have already defined four. "Judgments" refers to God's righteous decisions or legal decisions. "Commandments" are God's authoritative instructions. "Rules" refers to God's guidance. "Words" express God's revelation and guidance. At the heart of Psalm 119 is God's active presence with his people. "Psalm 119... intends by the form of its language to unlock the Torah as the medium of God's indwelling in those who pray this psalm." ~ James Hamilton, Psalms

Monday | Listen to [Psalm 119:161-168](#) | Listen to "Bless God"

Pray Psalm 119:161-168. God's story is all about the life, death, resurrection, and return of Jesus. How does a love for Scripture impact your love for Jesus? How can your love for Jesus shape your response to the truth, correction, and guidance of Scripture? How can a deep love for God's instruction lead to greater peace in your life and our world? Ask Jesus, "How does the truth of who you are need to shape my view of today?"

Tuesday | Listen to [Psalm 119:169-176](#) | Listen to "Spirit Of The Living God"

Pray Psalm 119:169-176. What is the psalmist longing for God to do, and how does that compare with the things on your heart today? What helps you be bold in bringing your requests to God? As you reflect on Psalm 119, how does this psalm help you to remember the indwelling Holy Spirit as you follow Jesus? Ask Jesus, "What truth about you do you want me to think about throughout today?"

Wednesday | Listen to [Psalm 19](#) | Listen to "What A Beautiful Name"

Consider the dual focus on nature and Scripture. What is unique about each in how they stir up awe and reverence for God within you? How are they similar? After a month of meditating on a psalm about God's loving instruction, how would you summarize your feelings about God's word? Ask Jesus, "Where do you want to show me your greatness and power today?"

Thursday | Listen to [1 Corinthians 15](#) | Listen to "Driven By Love"

God's story is all about the life, death, resurrection, and return of Jesus. Paul ends his argument for the centrality of the resurrection to the Gospel with a powerful "So what?" in verse 58. In light of our hope in Jesus, what's the encouragement he gives us? What is required to "be steadfast, immovable"? How do these words encourage you to keep going? Ask Jesus, "How are you calling me to remember your story today?"

Friday | Watch [Bible Project- Philemon Video](#) | Listen to "Good Grace" This weekend, we will launch a new series, little letters. The first letter we will look at is Philemon. How would you summarize this letter? Ask Jesus, "Where are you inviting me to develop deeper relationships with other followers?"
