**Big Idea: We each have a part in being and making
Word-dependent followers of Jesus.**

*Word-dependent: God has chosen to reveal Himself to people through the Word – through both
the written Word and the Living Word, Jesus. We build our lives upon God's Word.*

Word-dependence leads to looking more like Jesus.

Word-dependence embraces the process of transformation.

Word-dependence builds confidence in Jesus and following him.

Word-dependent... "As his followers, our lives are being transformed in His image. To be dependent upon the Word, we seek to understand what God has spoken through the Scriptures by the illumination of the Holy Spirit. We then diligently apply what the Spirit has revealed to our individual lives. Our lives are built upon doing what Jesus says, not simply building an archive of information of what God has said. To be Word-dependent is to believe in the authority, inerrancy, and sufficiency of the Scriptures for life and practice under the power of the Holy Spirit. Being Word-dependent is inseparable from being Spirit-empowered."

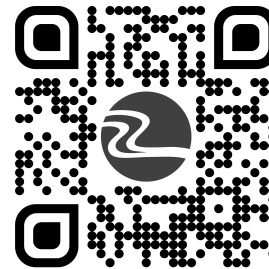

LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

Monday | Listen to [Psalm 119:41-48](#) | Watch [Bible Project Video-John 1](#)

Pray Psalm 119:41-48. Repetition can help us change how we think as we consider the significance of God's story in our lives each day. Where have you experienced freedom by walking according to God's truth? How does this contrast with the restrictions imposed by the world's values? How could you intentionally speak of God's activity in your daily life? Ask Jesus, "Is there someone I can share your goodness with today?"

Tuesday | Listen to [Psalm 119:49-56](#) | Listen to "Hope of the Ages"

Pray Psalm 119:49-56. Have you been in a situation where you were insulted for your faith or trust in God's word? When have you remembered God's truth, which brought you comfort and reassurance? How can you actively recall God's word during challenging times? How does praising and celebrating His word strengthen your faith journey? Ask Jesus, "What truth about you do you want me to think about throughout today?"

Wednesday | Listen to [Psalm 119:57-64](#) | Listen to "I Belong to Jesus"

Pray Psalm 119:57-64. What do you think about when you wake up in the middle of the night? What's your part in cultivating a heart for God's Word? Why is it important to have others who are following Jesus positively influence your spiritual journey? How can you strengthen these relationships for mutual encouragement and growth? Don't miss the opportunity to join others on your campus tonight at 6:45 pm for All-In Prayer Night!

Thursday | Listen to [Psalm 119:65-72](#) | Listen to "Good Plans"

Pray Psalm 119:65-72. Would you say you long to learn from God? Why or why not? How have you experienced God's goodness in your life personally? What challenges are you facing now that Jesus wants to transform into opportunities? How can you keep a love for God's Word even amid the struggle? Ask Jesus, "How do you want to encourage me?"

Friday | Listen to [Psalm 119:41-80](#) | Listen to "How Great"

Pray Psalm 119:73-80. How does knowing everything was created by and for Jesus impact how you think about life? How does it encourage you to seek him in all things? And yet, what are the things you hold back? Why is it important to remind yourself of God's steadfast love and its unearned nature?
