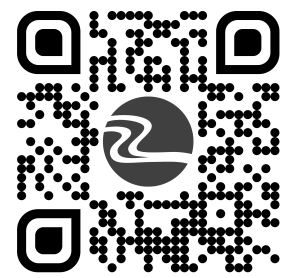

Monday | Read [Psalm 41](#) | Listen to [Crowns Down](#)

Christmas Songs point to a life lived under the perfect King. How do you see Psalm 41 reflected in the life and suffering of Jesus? What aspects of this psalm reflect Jesus' experiences, especially regarding betrayal and trust in God? How does knowing Jesus is the perfect King lower your resistance to living under the "rule" of another? Ask Jesus, "What area of insecurity do you want to speak truth over?"

Tuesday | Read [Luke 1](#) | Listen to [Manger Throne](#)

Life lived under the perfect King is the Gospel! The good news of God's story reaches its pinnacle in Jesus. Focus on Mary's song. What's her response based on? Where does she see herself in God's story? What echoes of Psalm 41:1-3 do you hear in her song? Ask Jesus, "Where are you asking me to live under your authority as my King?"

Wednesday | Read [John 13:1-30](#) | Listen to [Here I Am To Worship](#)

Life lived under the perfect king is where I'll find the life I've been looking for. What do you observe about Jesus's life and leadership here? How does humility help you find the life you are looking for? Betrayal is a major theme in Psalm 41 and here in John 13. How does betrayal by another person affect your relationship with Jesus? Ask Jesus, "Who can I serve today that does not deserve it?"

Thursday | Read [Luke 2:1-21](#) | Listen to [O Holy Night](#)

When we live under Jesus as our king, we can experience security and rest. Where do you see connections between the circumstances of Jesus' birth and the kind of king he showed himself to be in John 13? How does humility in leadership build your confidence in a leader? Where do you need to reflect this in your relationships today? Ask Jesus, "What can I do to put you at the center of my/our Christmas celebration this year?"

Friday | Listen to [Psalm 41](#) & [Psalm 150](#) | Listen to [Endless Praise](#)

Christmas Songs point to a life lived under the perfect King. Psalm 41 ends with praise, the only fitting response to Jesus as our King. How can you fill your day with praise? What patterns in your daily life can serve as reminders to praise? What might it look like to move praise beyond words to action? Fill your day with praise.
