LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

Monday | Read/Listen to Psalm 110 | Worship to "See A Victory"

Jesus is the only way to live in the kingdom of God. How does the imagery of enemies being made a footstool for the Messiah reflect Jesus' triumph over sin and death? What has that triumph meant for you? What would it look like to live today in that victory reality? Ask Jesus, "How does the reality of the resurrection inspire my normal life?" Live inspired today!

Tuesday | Read/Listen to Acts 2:14-41 | Worship to "No Body"

The resurrection and rule of Jesus assure us that sin and death are defeated. What is Peter emphasizing? What truth about Jesus stood out most to you in this passage? What does it look like to be "devoted" to something? How does the reality of the resurrection inspire your devotion to learning more about who Jesus is and following him in everyday life? Ask Jesus, "How can I honor you today?" Live it out!

Wednesday | Read/Listen to Hebrews 5:1-10; 7:1-8:2 | Worship to "You Alone" Jesus is the High Priest who gives access to God's Kingdom. What kinds of things come to mind when you hear the word "priest"? How does understanding Jesus as a priest affect how you think of him? How could the priesthood of Jesus impact your approach to prayer and worship? Ask Jesus, "What conversation do you want me to have with you today?"

Thursday | Read/Listen to Psalm 110 & Acts 2:14-21 | Worship to "Bless God"

Jesus, the King and High Priest, requires a response. How does this Psalm contrast with your perceptions of Jesus? Consider the crowd's reaction in Acts 2; what does it look like for you to "turn and go in the other direction" (repent) as you follow Jesus? How does the truth that Jesus is the forever King promised in Psalm 110 inspire your followership? Ask Jesus, "Who do you want me to pray for today? How do you want me to pray for them?"

Friday | Watch Galatians Video | Worship to "King of Kings"

We are following Jesus, the King who rules the kingdom of God, which means he is worthy of our preparation in worship. As you consider gathering with other followers of Jesus, what does it look like to be prepared to give and receive in the worship experience? How does preparing for the weekend demonstrate that Jesus is worthy of worship? What's the big picture of Galatians? Write a one-sentence summary. Ask Jesus, "What do you want me to give you in worship?"
