LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

Monday | Read/Listen to 1 Tim. 6:3-21 | Worship to "I'd Rather Have Jesus"

A faith-filled community finds contentment in Christ. Reflect on the beliefs you feel most strongly about. Do you ever find yourself pulled into the conversations mentioned in verse 4? How is contentment opposed to these things? How does contentment impact others as we follow Jesus together? Ask Jesus, "How can I encourage others by my attitude this week?"

Tuesday | Read/Listen to 1 Tim. 6:3-21 | Worship to "The Lord Will Provide" Greed is a downward spiral that leads to ruin. Take an honest look at how you view your financial/material situation. Where have you seen the love of money producing evil in your world or the world around you? Are there ways that the love of money might influence your decisions or priorities? What do you want God to work on in your heart? Tell him. Ask Jesus, "Where am I looking to find

my satisfaction in life outside of you?"

Wednesday | Read Phil. 4:10-13 and 2 Cor. 12:1-10 | Worship to "Shall Not Want" The antidote to greed is contentment. How would you describe the perspective Paul has about his circumstances? What do you think is his "secret?" What would it look like for you to take the same view? Are there areas in your life where you find yourself constantly wanting more? How can you shift your focus from acquiring more to being grateful for what God has done and is doing for you? Ask Jesus, "Remind me of how you've provided for me and those I love."

Thursday | Read/Listen to Matt. 6:19-34 | Worship to "I Shall Not Want"

Contentment is experienced as we connect to Jesus. How easily do you trust God to provide for your daily needs? What does that look like? Both Jesus and Paul say we can be content with having our food and clothing taken care of. Do you agree? Do we deserve more? Are there specific worries or anxieties that you struggle to release to him? What steps could you take to strengthen your confidence that God will provide? Ask Jesus, "Who do you want me to pray for today?"

Friday | Watch the BibleProject video on 2 Timothy | Worship to "Always Enough" A faith-filled community finds contentment in Christ. What questions are you still wrestling with after seeing what the Bible says about contentment? As you reflect on our time in 1 Timothy, what is sticking with you? As we look forward to worshiping together this weekend, how can you prepare yourself not just to be ministered to but also to minister to others? What opportunities might you have?
