



LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

In Psalm 119, "law" is Torah. Torah is "instruction" or "teaching" and also refers to the first 5 books of the Old Testament. It is a comprehensive idea that impacts all of life. Ultimately, the Torah is a story leading us to Jesus. Connecting this truth to reading "law" in this Psalm can bring greater clarity and love for what God has given us in the written Word.

Monday | Listen to Psalm 119:81-88 | Listen to That's The Power

Pray Psalm 119:81-88. We have God's story to lead us to Jesus. How can you link this powerful Psalm to not only the written Word but also the living Word? The tension between following Jesus and living with people actively opposed to him is the reality of a follower of Jesus. What encouragement does this Psalm have for us in this struggle? Worship Jesus!

Tuesday | Listen to Psalm 119:89-96 | Listen to I've Witnessed It

Pray Psalm 119:89-96. The everlasting perfection of God's Word answers the struggle presented in the previous stanza (v81-88). How can sharing God's faithfulness in your faith journey encourage and inspire others to pursue Jesus? When have you diligently sought God in Scripture? What were the results? How does remembering encourage you?

Wednesday | Listen to Psalm 119:97-104 | Listen to Abide


Pray Psalm 119:97-104. What we think about reveals what we love. What does thinking about God's instruction/teaching that leads us to Jesus mean? Meditating upon God's ways is more than a daily "quiet time." How can this Psalm help you think about the way of Jesus throughout today? During a walk outside? During a crisis at work? Ask Jesus, "What truth about you do you want me to dwell on today?"

Thursday | Listen to Psalm 119:105-112 | Listen to The Word Remains

Pray Psalm 119:105-112. Describe specific ways God's written Word has guided you. How has focus on the written Word brought Jesus to mind? If it hasn't, consider the implications that Jesus is the living Word of God. How does this impact how you might pray Psalm 119? Ask Jesus, "What area in my life do you want to speak into?"

Friday | Listen to Psalm 119:81-120 | Watch BibleProject Video

Pray Psalm 119:113-120. As you grow in your understanding of what the Bible is, how does this impact the way you read it? How is it impacting your love of scripture? Your love and worship of God?
