Monday | Read/Listen to Leviticus 19 | Worship to "Resurrender"

God's people are set apart to live out his Presence in community. How does the call to "be holy" shape your understanding of what it means to reflect God's presence in your community? How does your treatment of others, especially those different from you or in need, reflect your commitment to living as one of God's set-apart people? Ask Jesus, "What structures can I put in my life to remind me of the reality of your presence?"

Tuesday | Read/Listen to John 1:1-34 | Worship to "With Us"

We live "set apart" because God is with us. How does the truth that Jesus is both the eternal Word and the One who takes away the sin of the world empower you to live "set apart" for God's purposes in a world that often opposes him? How has Leviticus shaped how you hear this passage? Ask Jesus, "What structures can I put in my life to remind me of the reality of your presence?"

Wednesday | Watch BibleProject Video - Holiness | Worship to "Holy Song"

We live "set apart" because we belong to God. How does understanding God's holiness as both dangerous and life-giving reshape how you approach him daily? In what ways does Jesus' life, death, and resurrection demonstrate the concept of God's holiness, making us clean and set apart for his purposes? How does God's holiness change how you interact with other people? Ask Jesus, "What structures can I put in my life to remind me of the reality of your presence?"

Thursday | Read/Listen to Leviticus 23-25 | Worship to "Throne Room Song"

We structure our lives to keep us connected to the reality of God's presence. How do the appointed festivals provide a rhythm that reminds God's people of his presence? What does it look like for you to create regular practices in your life to stay aware of God's presence? How does this command reveal God's desire for his people to trust his provision and presence? Ask Jesus, "What structures can I put in my life to remind me of the reality of your presence?"

Friday | Read/Listen to Mark 12:28-34 | Worship to "Tabernacle"

God's people are set apart to live out his Presence in community. How do you live now that God has moved in? In what ways does loving your neighbor as yourself embody the principles found in Leviticus about living in holiness and justice within the community? Write down one principle from this series you need to take forward in your life. Ask Jesus, "What structures can I put in my life to remind me of the reality of your presence?"
