## What is Student Leadership?

Student Leadership is for MSM and HSM students who want to lead by service. Student Leaders desire to further their relationship with Jesus and grow in leadership by serving others during Wednesday Nights, events, and church-wide occasions. In Student Leadership, the church staff team gives away some of the responsibilities of the ministry to the people that know it best: students.

## What's the Purpose?

The purpose of Student Leadership is to allow students to learn more about following Jesus by getting practical experience in doing the things that he did; loving others by serving them. With Student Leadership, we are asking for your help. We want to run the ministry *with* you, not just *for* you!

## Ways to serve with Student Leadership (check mark your interests):

- **Worship Team:** serve with Daniel Roybal and other students through instruments and vocals to help create an atmosphere of genuine worship and praise to God (new worship members apply at <https://2rc.tv/studentauditions/>)
- **Host Team:** Welcoming new students, connecting them to small groups and SG Leader. Helping with announcements, games, & connections.
- **Event Planning/Execution:** help plan what you want to see at our student ministry events, and be there to help make it happen!
- **Tech:** running the soundboard during Wednesday Night and/or running the lighting system
- **Media:** running any teaching slides, graphics, and music in ProPresenter on Mac

## What are the Expectations?

- Consistently spending time with God through prayer, worship, and Bible study and allowing the Holy Spirit to transform you.
- Live a life worth living! Be an example of Jesus to the people around you by walking in wisdom (Ephesians 5:15-17; 1 Peter 5:2-5) in *and* outside of church. This means that your actions, including how you treat people, the language you use, the contents of text/phone conversations, what you post on social media, and following the law (specifically in regards to alcohol and drugs) should all point people to Jesus. You are a Leader so people will look to you for guidance. Walk in a manner worthy of this calling (Ephesians 4:1-3).
- Committing to actively participate in all Leadership Meetings (within reason), take part in discussions, complete any readings, and any further needs for the Student Leadership Team. Setting aside at least one Sunday afternoon a month for Student Leadership Team meetings.
- Regularly attend MSM/HSM: actively participate as much as possible in Wednesday Nights (including Small Group, games, conversations with others) and other events (Fall Camp, mission trips, outings, etc.). If you are leading the ministry you need to be there often!
- Regularly attend weekend services (Saturday PM/Sunday AM) at Two Rivers Church. You are not only a Leader on Wednesday, but all week, so it is important for you to connect to the greater family at 2RC.

## Covenant

If I am asked to join the Student Leadership Team, I will agree to the expectations outlined above and specifically...

- **Let my relationship with Jesus influence my whole life.** I will live a life that looks like Jesus is in it by representing him to my family, friends, and the adults in my life.
- **Be held accountable.** I understand that no one is perfect, and we all make mistakes. This is okay and expected. I will agree to being held responsible to the expectations of, first and foremost, a Christian and, secondly, a Student Leader by my Student Pastor and my peers when appropriate.
