LIVE IT OUT | A DAILY DISCIPLESHIP GUIDE

Listen to this Week's Sermon Find this week's advent videos at 2RC.tv/LiveltOut

Living Advent will have a video every day for our daily discipleship guide. Use the video to help you consider how you can live out the reality of both the birth and return of Jesus every day, as the life, death, resurrection, and return of Jesus are both a present reality and future hope.

Sunday | Watch Advent Video: Day 8

Watch the video as a family. What does it mean to experience "peace" in life? How can talking about Jesus in everyday stressful circumstances make a difference in how you experience his peace? Ask Jesus who you can pray for today, and then do it!

Monday | Watch Advent Video: Day 9

When have you seen God use the insignificant or overlooked to accomplish his purpose? Where in your life do you feel small or insignificant? How might God be working through you in those areas? Ask Jesus, "Who needs to know that you see them today?"

Tuesday | Watch Advent Video: Day 10

Read Luke 2:1-11. The story of Christmas never gets old. Why do you think that is? What do you hear in this passage that reminds you of the peace of Jesus' first and second "advent"? Ask Jesus, "Who do you want me to pray for today?"

Wednesday | Watch Advent Video: Day 11

What are the areas of your life that feel chaotic or unsettled? How can you invite Jesus to bring his peace into those spaces? Pray, inviting Jesus into the areas of your life void of his peace.

Thursday | Watch Advent Video: Day 12

Begin today by reading Matthew 1:18-24. How does the reality of Jesus with us through the indwelling Spirit help give you peace? How can personal worship help you keep centered on this truth? Watch the video and worship.

Friday | Watch Advent Video: Day 13

How do you intentionally keep your eyes on Jesus in the Christmas season? How is the surprise and wonder of Christmas morning a glimpse of what's possible with Jesus in everyday life? Ask Jesus, "How do you want me to pray today?"

Saturday | Watch Advent Video: Day 14

How does knowing that Jesus is "Faithful and True" shape your trust in him during this Advent season? How does the image of Jesus in Revelation challenge or comfort you as you reflect on his coming? Ask Jesus, "How can I prepare my heart to live in anticipation of your return?"
