Listen to this Week's Sermon

Monday | Read/Listen to Matt. 3:1-12 | Worship to "Lead Me To The Cross" Repentance is unveiled as the pathway to life. John the Baptist boldly announces that the kingdom of heaven has arrived, calling people to repentance. What does John's message teach us about the urgency of repentance? How does he describe the difference between g e nuine repentance and empty religious activity? Ask Jesus, "Where are you calling me to turn toward you today?"

Tuesday | Read/Listen to Ezekiel 18 | Worship to "Wonder"

God's "good news" has always been about life in his kingdom. God warns that sin leads to ruin and destruction. But his desire is to bring life - not death! What does this passage reveal about God's heart toward those who repent? Why would God connect repentance with a "new heart" and "new spirit"? How does this change how you view repentance? Ask Jesus, "Where are you calling me to turn toward you today?"

Wednesday | Read/Listen to Psalm 32 | Worship to "Running Back To You"

Hiding sin only leads to more pain, but bringing it into the light leads to healing and life. Have you ever felt the weight of unconfessed sin or avoidance of the idea altogether? How did it affect you? What does this passage teach us about the freedom and blessing that come with repentance? Ask Jesus, "Where are you calling me to turn toward you today?"

Thursday | Read/Listen to Galatians 5:16-26 | Worship to "Jesus Have It All" Repentance is demonstrated and results in a fruit-filled life. How does Paul describe the difference between a life led by the Spirit and a life controlled by sin? What evidence of the "fruit of the Spirit" do you see growing in your life? What area of your life still needs to be surrendered to God so the Holy Spirit can bring transformation? Ask Jesus, "Where are you calling me to turn toward you today?"

Friday | Read/Listen to Psalm 105 | Worship to "Glorious Day"

Repentance is unveiled as the pathway to life. Repentance is more than sorrow over sin; it's reorienting our lives toward Jesus, recognizing his goodness, and stepping into the life he offers. Why does the psalmist emphasize remembering God's deeds? How does this impact our faith? How can looking back at God's faithfulness encourage you to turn toward Him today? Ask Jesus, "Where are you calling me to turn toward you today?"
