Listen to this Week's Sermon

Monday | Read/Listen to Matt. 3:13-17 | Worship to "Lord Of My Life"

Jesus is unveiled as the Savior, completing God's redemptive plan. What does Jesus' baptism reveal about His obedience to God? How does the Father's declaration shape your understanding of Jesus' identity? How does this passage challenge or strengthen your faith in Jesus? Ask Jesus, "How can I grow in obedience and submission to you?" Register for Serve Saturday!

Tuesday | Read/Listen to Isaiah 42:1-4 | Worship to "Cornerstone"

Meditate on these 4 verses. Jesus is revealed as the completion of Israel's story. Why is it significant that Jesus is described as God's chosen Servant? How does Jesus bring justice differently than worldly rulers? How does knowing Jesus fulfills God's promises impact your trust in him? Ask Jesus, "What does intentionally following you look like today?"

Wednesday | Read/Listen to Psalm 2 | Worship to "Revelation Song"

Jesus' identity demands a response from us. What does it mean for Jesus to be the Son of God and the King? How does recognizing Jesus as King change the way you live? What areas of your life do you need to submit more fully to His authority? What are some of the factors that make it hard for you to submit? Ask Jesus, "Where do I tend to hold back from fully following you?"

Thursday | Read/Listen to Rom 6:1-11 | Worship to "Beneath The Waters"

One way we demonstrate the new life we have is by being baptized. How does baptism reflect our identification with Jesus' death and resurrection? What does it mean for you to walk in the "newness of life" today? What intentional choices can you make to follow Jesus today? Ask Jesus to make it real for you.

Friday | Read/Listen to Matthew 1-3:17 | Worship to "All Hail King Jesus"

Matthew's opening chapters reveal Jesus as the fulfillment of prophecy, the true King, and the beloved Son who brings salvation to the world. How do the first three chapters establish Jesus as the Messiah? What connections do you see between Jesus' genealogy, birth, early life, and baptism? How has your understanding of Jesus grown through studying these chapters? What's one thing from this week that you need to make sure you *live out* intentionally moving forward?
