Listen to this Week's Sermon

Monday | Read/Listen to Matthew 4:12-16 | Worship to "Glory to Glory" Jesus unveils the completion of God's promise to bring liberation and joy to all. The people in Galilee lived in deep spiritual darkness, yet Jesus came to them first. How does this show God's heart for the lost and the broken? How can you reflect that same heart by bringing his light to someone in your life this week? Where do you see Jesus' light at work? Ask Jesus, "How can I experience more freedom, joy, and peace in your story?"

Tuesday | Read/Listen to John 1:1-18 | Worship to "Fountains"

Jesus is the true light that shines into the darkness. What does it mean that Jesus is the "true light" of the world? How have you seen the darkness of our world recently? How do you tend to respond? How have you seen Jesus shining in the darkness? How can that change your response? Ask Jesus, "What do I need to do today to remember your victory and your light?"

Wednesday | Read/Listen to Isaiah 9:1-7 | Worship to "Prince of Peace"

Jesus' presence brings freedom, joy, and peace. How does this passage help you better understand why Jesus came? What specific promises made about the Messiah do you most deeply long to experience? How can you remind yourself today of the freedom, joy, and peace that can only be found in Jesus? Who else can you encourage? Ask Jesus, "How do you want to use me as I live in your light today?"

Thursday | Read/Listen to Col. 1:9-23 | Worship to "Because of Jesus"

Stepping into God's story by faith is how we experience his presence. What does it mean to you that you have been reconciled to Jesus? How does knowing that Jesus is at the center of God's story give you confidence to follow him by faith, even when circumstances seem uncertain? What is one way you can actively hold fast to the hope of the gospel today? How can spiritual practices help you hold fast? Ask Jesus, "How do you want me to pray right now?"

Friday | Read/Listen to Psalm 27 | Worship to "King of Kings"

Jesus unveils the completion of God's promise to bring liberation and joy to all. Read/listen to the psalm at least 2 more times. What do you "hear" God communicating to you in these ancient lyrics?
