

Listen to this Week's Sermon Live It Out Podcast: Easter Eggs week 4

Monday | Read/Listen to Psalm 105 | Worship to "Your Great Name"

Jesus' death and resurrection set us free. What does this reveal about God's control over history and human hearts? What does this reveal about God's character in keeping covenant promises? In what ways does God's redemption bring more than escape? How does this verse reshape your view of what it means to be delivered? What does it mean to receive freedom and live in it? Ask Jesus, "Where are you calling me to step fully into the freedom you have given?"

Tuesday | Read/Listen to Romans 8:1-17 | Worship to "O Come To the Altar"

We are now free from sin and death. Are there areas where you still hold onto guilt that Christ has already freed you from? How can you focus your thoughts and desires on the things of the Spirit? Are the spiritual disciplines you find helpful? How does understanding your identity as God's child shape your relationships with Jesus and others? Ask Jesus, "What questions about my identity should I ask you?"

Wednesday | Read/Listen to Romans 6:1-4 | Worship to "Rise Up"

We are now free to live the life we were made to live with Jesus. Meditate upon this passage. What does it mean to identify so fully with Jesus that his death marks the end of your old way of life? What does it stir in you to know that this same power is at work in you today? Consider what "newness" really implies. It's not a tweak or reset, but an entirely different kind of life. Ask Jesus, "What old patterns or mindsets no longer belong on this path?"

Thursday | Read/Listen to Galatians 5:1-6:10 | Worship to "Build My Life"

We demonstrate our freedom in Gospel-centered generosity, forgiveness, and service. Meditate on ways your freedom in Christ should naturally lead to a life of generosity, forgiveness, and service. Which of these do you find the most rewarding? Which is the most challenging? How can you intentionally grow in one of them? Ask Jesus, "Which of these expressions of the Gospel are you challenging me to take a next step?" Sign up for Serve Saturday, April 26th!

Friday | Read/Listen to John 18-19 | Worship to "Goodbye Yesterday"

Jesus' death and resurrection set us free. What does it say about true authority that the One with all power chooses restraint, even in the face of injustice? What do you see when you behold Jesus bruised and crowned, not in weakness, but in willing obedience? How does this inspire how you approach today?
