

Summary

The Global Technical Director oversees all audio and technical aspects of church worship experiences and events. This role requires leadership, technical expertise, creativity, and the ability to work collaboratively with various teams to enhance the worship experience. This position is responsible for ensuring excellent audio and technical quality for all events within its scope of responsibility. Recruiting, training, and empowering volunteers are key components of this position.

Major Responsibilities

- Technical Oversight—Lead and manage all aspects of audio and tech equipment required for church services, events, and special productions, making sure all spaces are prepared before events. Ensure all equipment is properly maintained and functioning at all times.
- Training and Development—Recruit, train, and develop tech volunteers, fostering a culture of excellence, teamwork, and care. Provide ongoing training and support to team members to build their confidence and enhance their skills and capabilities. Partner alongside the Production Director to create, grow, and sustain all visual/audio elements and care for a shared volunteer community.
- Collaboration and Planning—Collaborate with the Production Director and Worship Leaders to ensure the tech equipment across all campuses is functioning. Schedule tech volunteers to ensure a frequency that balances the tension required for consistent proficiency and avoids overuse.
- Resource Management - Manage tech budgets, procure equipment, and oversee purchasing, ensuring responsible stewardship of resources. Research and recommend new technologies or upgrades that improve production quality and efficiency within the budgeting process.
