Scripture: Matthew 20:17-21:22

Big Idea: I confront the world's upside-down values by serving others.

Questions for Connection (*Use these to help start conversations*)

1. Who is someone you really looked up to when you were young, and why?
2. What's something you don't enjoy doing in your job, but you know it's necessary?

Take a moment to stop and ask the Holy Spirit to guide the rest of the discussion.

Read Matthew 20:17-21:22

1. Is there any area or time of your life that you have struggled with feeling entitled to be served? What was your life with Jesus like at that time?
2. What do our lives look like if Jesus' authority (healing and judgment) shapes how we live? Is there a time in your life you responded differently than you normally would have in response to recognizing Jesus' authority?
3. Is there anything in your life that, on the surface, looks good, that God may want you to go deeper? If someone looked at your life over the last year, what fruit would they say stands out?
4. Who do you naturally gravitate towards serving? Who is the hardest to serve?
5. Over this week in "Live It Out", was there anything you wanted to discuss?
6. As we start the Winter Quarter, how can we as a group ensure we are genuine with one another, rather than just "looking good"? **Take time to pray for authenticity and openness to change.**
